## The Suffering Servant of God Isaiah 52:13-53:12

Jews claim Isaiah 53 is talking about suffering of the nation of Israel. In this chapter, the personal pronoun "He" is used 18 times, "His" is used 13 times, & "Him" is used 10 times, which means God used personal pronouns 41 times to prove this coming Messiah will suffer for the sins of the people. Furthermore, He is contrasted to the people in v 8. Isa 53:1A, Paul quotes this verse in Rom. 10:16, & says Isaiah is talking about Jesus. Arm of the Lord means saving power of God, Isa 53:1B, cf: Exo 6:6. Christ's vicarious atonement Isa 53:2-4. Stripes Isa 53:5 cf: Matt 27:26, All are sinners Isa 53:6, cf: Rom 3:10-20. Opened not His mouth Isa 53:7, cf John 19:10. Isa 53:8 Prison cf: Matt 27:27-29, "Judgment" cf: Mat 27:19, He is to be Killed, Isa 53:8. He is crucified with "Wicked" cf: Mat 27:38. Isa 53:9A. Buried rich man's tomb, Isa 53:9B, Mat 27:57-60. God will see His "seed or child, & prolong His days, Isa 53:10, How? When He has been killed in v 8, buried in v 9 ? God will resurrect Him from the Grave, Gen 3:15 & Gal. 3:16, Because of His atonement, He is now called a righteous Servant, Isa. 53:11, cf: II Cor 5:21, who will justify many & Rom. 3:21ff. Isa 53:12, there is just one mediator between God and men I Tim 2:5 .

## Isaiah 52:13-53-12

"Behold my servant"-fulfilled- Philippians 2:6-8. "He shall be...very high" From the Hebrew word gaw-bah, "be, (make) high, lift up, mount up, raise up, great height, upward"-fulfilled- John 3:14; 8:28; 12:32; 19:16-18. Isaiah 52:14His visage was so marred, more than any man..." The suffering Servant, the coming Messiah, is to be beaten and marred more than any man. Most people

Today have a very poor, at best, understanding of the suffering of Christ. We need to go back and read the accounts found near the end of each of the four Gospels.

"So shall He (the Messiah) sprinkle..." an unusual play on words here, not Hebrew zaw-rak', to sprinkle fluid, to be here and there scatter, sprinkle or strew. This is not the word used, but rather naw-zaw', to spirit, be sprinkle especially in expiation. This word is used only to describe the priests work of sprinkling blood (Exodus 29:21- Aaron himself), the household of Aaron, the priest, (Leviticus 4:6,17;5:9; 14:7,51; 16:14-15 and 16:19), and the anointing of the cleansed by the blood, with oil: (Leviticus 14:16 & 27).It is also interesting to note that Christ, our great high Priest, " entered by his own blood and now when we are baptized (not sprinkled) into His death (Romans 6:3-6) we come into contact with the blood and receive the gift of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:38-39). The Oil (Luke 4:18; Hebrews 1:9 and 11 Corinthians 1;21-22).

Who will the Messiah cleanse by the sprinkling of His blood? "Many nations". Again we see that the result of His work is the conversation of the gentiles-fulfilled-Luke 24:44-47. Isaiah Chapter 53 Throughout this chapter the Hebrew word Hoo is used to describe the Messiah- the Suffering Servant. The Hebrew word Hoo is a third person personal pronoun, singular, and it is translated properly into English as He, Him or His. God used it 41 times in this chapter to show it is the Messiah not the nation of Israel nor the people who will suffer and atone for sin.
